112101 Welcome The Chair welcomed everyone present at the meeting.

112103 Public Session It was suggested that NYCC be requested to provide slippery road sign to the Parish Council who could then erect them when required.

The Clerk was asked to contact Arriva to ask for timetable information to be provided at bus stops.

The Environment Agency was criticised for allowing their contractor to leave debris after they leave the various compounds. Clerk to contact EA.

112104 Minutes of previous meeting **Resolved** The minutes of the Meetings of the 19th October 2021 were approved and signed by the Chair.

112105 Cllr. Reports Cllr. Tams reported that he had purchased fixings for the new benches (£131.76), replacement xmas lights (£42.99) and remembrance poppies (£99.90).

Resolved The Clerk was authorised to make the appropriate payment.

Cllr. Tams summarised the work of 20Plenty who had contacted him.

- 112106 Clerk's Report** The NYCC contact suggested by Cllr. Jordan regarding parking on Bird Lane is not available at the moment.
- The erection of a litter bins on Station Road has been ordered.
- NYCC have cleared most of the footpath on the A 645
- The screening of the light from LP 36 has been completed.
- The proposals for the new Unitary Authority are to be the subject of webinars hosted by NYCC. Members have the details.
- 112107 Planning** Applications Dove Cote Farm Bungalow 4 new dwellings
- It was considered that the number of properties was excessive particularly on the Field Lane frontage where the indicative parking arrangement would create a long length of vehicular crossing of the only footway.
- It should also be noted that a lighting column will need to be replaced

- 112108 Parish Field** The Clerk is to formally contact the Solicitor to seek final clarification that clearance can commence.
- 112109 Gale Common Funding.** Payment by Internet Banking can now proceed.
- 112110 Flood Banking** The use by walkers is still awaiting further discussions with the EA and both of the farmers involved.
- 112111 Station Road Play Area** The benches have now arrived and the bases constructed and the levelling of the ground is now required
- 112112 Low Cost Housing** The wording of the village survey which will take place in the new year has now been agreed to reflect the Parish Councils concerns.
- 112113 Disabled Access to the Station Road play area.** No further contact from Selby DC has been made.
- 112114 Xmas Lighting** Following a discussion regarding the Xmas Lights around the village it was agreed that a small group be formed to review the present arrangements.
