- 011810 Play Areas** A set of possible option has been provided by Hags. It was agreed that Groundwork should continue to develop a set of proposals and look into possible funding sources.

- Resolved** **After a general discussion is was agreed to set a precept based on an increase of 2.5 % which equates to £14,925 after rounding.**
- 011812 Eggborough CCGT** A drop-in session for the public is to be arranged in the village where residents can see the proposals first hand. The Inspector has insisted that the demolition of the existing power station be included as part of the new proposals.
- 011813 Grass Cutting Contract** The period for invitations to tender has now been completed with two expression of interest. Tender documents will now be issued.
- 011814 Additional Verge and Hedge Cutting.** The initial cut has now been completed. It was agreed to initially have three cuts per year.
