- 041809 Coal Authority** No further information is available.
- 041810 Land Transfer** Land Transfer for the area on Dove Cote Gardens has been completed.
- 041811 Lighting Columns** The visual inspection of the columns has now been completed and the condition rated. As part of the inspection column 70 was immediately removed as it was considered dangerous. Column 31 had already been removed as it was damaged.
After a detailed discussion it was agreed that columns 31 and 70 be replaced during this financial year along with column 42 which could not be repaired due to wiring problems.
- 041812 Variable speed signs** NYCC are currently consulting with Parish Councils regarding the existing policy with regard to the use of VMS signs and they have circulated a questionnaire regarding these.
It was agreed that the existing use of the NYCC VMS signs was not affordable and Parish Councils should be allowed to use and manage their own signs.
- 041813 Station Road Play Area** Cllr.Elliott-Adams outlined the progress for the refurbishment of the equipment and the possibilities for obtaining grants.
