012001 Welcome The Chair welcomed everyone present at the meeting.

012004 Minutes of previous meeting Resolved

The minutes of the Meetings of the 26th November 2019 were approved and signed by the Chair.

012005 Cllr. Reports The visit to the Highview Power energy production facility has been postponed.

012007 Clerks report Eggborough Power Station Public Exhibition of the redevelopment.

The plans on display showed substantial warehousing with a new roundabout on the A19.

Lighting Column 15 has been repaired.

The site meeting at the A645 traffic signals had taken place and the timing between the red signal to the A645 and the start of the pedestrian phase is to be increased to ensure that pedestrians are not given a green light before traffic has cleared the junction.

Additional signing to warn traffic of the crossing is also to be erected.

The requirements for the introduction of a 30 mph speed limit were explained but was agreed that a request be submitted to NYCC for this to be implemented, even if only at school start and finish times.

Concerns at the speed of traffic are to be sent to the police asking for enforcement action and the Community Speed Watch is to be resurrected.

012008 Glass Form Factory, Heck The developer has sent a consultation document prior to applying for planning permission.

012009 Church Lane Footway The works to prevent the flooding of the footway are scheduled to take place commencing on the 15th February during the half term break.

No details of the proposed works have been provided and the concern that this will not remove the problem unless the footway is raised remain.

The Parish Council contribution to the cost of the scheme will not be paid until the works can be shown to resolve the problem after heavy rainfall.

012010 Mobile Home Wand Lane An attempt to clear the dwelling has been made but this had been unsuccessful.
A letter is to be sent to the owner to ensure the removal is completed.

012011 2020/21 Precept The Clerk outlined the options for the next financial year including a projected end of year forecast together with alternative strategies.

Resolved That the precept for 2020/21 bet set at £15,250
